What is the point of this page? It is to make your readers aware of the sources you used throughout your work on a project. That means it must include *all* of the sources you used while researching the topic, whether you quoted from those sources or not.

In general, this page will be a list. This list will clearly and completely compile your sources at the end of your work so readers can easily see where your research comes from. So, one of the main purposes of this page is to give credit where credit is due. Avoid plagiarism by including all of your research material on this page.

THINGS TO KNOW:

- These pages are all the same. They are a list of sources that you used to prepare your research paper.
- It is always the last page of the report.
- It is listed in alphabetical order by the author's last name or by the article title (if there is no author).
- Each citation gets its own line. If the citation runs to the next line, you need to indent the second line 5 spaces.
- Titles of books, encyclopedias, magazines, newspapers, etc. are in italics.
- Article titles are placed in quotation marks and the period goes inside the ending quotation mark.
