Citing Magazines (MLA)

Author. "Article Title." *Magazine Name* Date published: Page number(s). Type of publication.

SAMPLE:

Smith, Jane. "The best ways to lose weight." *Health and Nutrition* 5 January 2015: 19-21. Print.

Citing Newspapers (MLA)

Author. "Article Title." *Newspaper Name* Date published: Page number. Type of publication.

SAMPLE:

Benson, Meg. "Kennett Crossroads: Conversations with headliners - Noll Billings & Blackjack Billy." *Daily Dunklin Democrat* 9 January 2015: E1. Print.
