You will go to [www.almanac4kids.com](http://www.almanac4kids.com) to answer the following questions.

1. Click on Pets. Note the First Birds. How many are listed?
2. What does it mean by "First"?
3. Scroll down and read about cats. Using prior knowledge, what do indoor cats usually cover their poop with?
4. Click on Outdoors. Read about animal group names. What do you call a group of ponies?
5. Click on Skywatch. Change your location to Kennett, MO. What time will the sun rise? And what time will the sun set?
6. Write out another question here of your choice. Be sure and tell Mrs. Anderson what to click on to find the answer.

This is a new building that was not listed in our 2003 Almanac the other day when we were looking at it in the library. What is the name of this building? How many stories is this building? And how tall is this building?
